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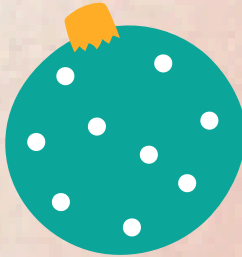

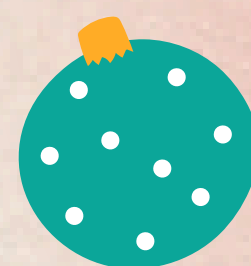

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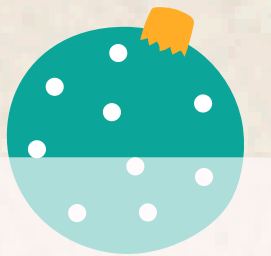


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inspirED Reader & Writer

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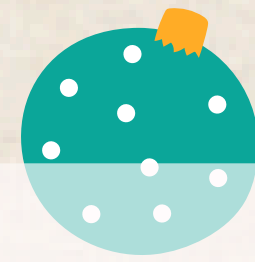
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Creative Writing

The Polar Express

This immersive, project-based literacy course uses Chris Van Allsburg's classic, *The Polar Express*, as the central text for a week of academic exploration and fun. Designed for students in Grades 1 and 2, this workshop focuses on building a solid foundation in essential reading and writing skills through an engaging, familiar narrative.

Our goal is not just to read a story, but to actively engage with it, allowing students to develop both their academic vocabulary and their confidence as communicators. Students will move beyond basic comprehension to analyze the text, articulate their ideas, and express themselves in various written forms.



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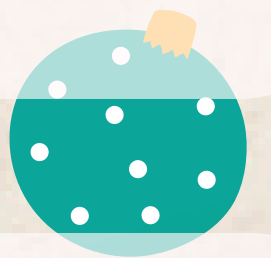

Yule Love Writing

Yule Love Writing is a high-impact, focused workshop all about the Christmas season! Students will develop their language arts skills in a fun and engaging writer's workshop. Designed for students in Grades 3 and 4, this course challenges young authors to move beyond simple narratives and practice the courage and discipline required for effective creative expression.

We use a project-based approach, dedicating the week to the study and application of multiple literary genres. Our focus is on building competence in structure, refining voice, and clarity of purpose across diverse forms of writing. By the end of the week, each student will have completed a substantial portfolio of ten distinct pieces (seven stories and three poems), showcasing their progress in composition and revision.



Creative Writing

Travel Journalling

Travel Journalling is an imaginative workshop designed to teach students in Grades 3 and 4 how to transform their winter break experiences—whether a family trip or a reflective staycation—into engaging written and visual memoirs. This course offers a creative space for students to process and articulate their adventures, turning temporary moments into lasting, cherished records.

Students will be actively encouraged to step into the role of a thoughtful observer, using the "scrap-booking" style to combine descriptive writing with artistic elements. The primary goal is to inspire students to fully engage with their surroundings during their time off, creating a beautiful and comprehensive travel journal ready to document their most recent winter experiences.

A Glimpse into the Future

A Glimpse into the Future: Global Perspectives in Creative Writing (Grades 5–6)

In an era defined by rapid change, the skill of imagining—and articulating—future possibilities is more critical than ever. A Glimpse into the Future is an intensive creative writing and literature workshop that prepares students in Grades 5 and 6 to become active participants in shaping the world narrative.

This course moves beyond conventional storytelling by examining literature from diverse, international writers who pose essential questions about society, technology, and humanity's trajectory. Students will engage critically with these texts to broaden their awareness of global issues, serving as the foundation for their own original predictive writing. Our goal is to empower students to write not just about what could be, but about a future they actively seek.

G7 – 8 AGES 12 – 13

Academic Writing

This course delves into research methods and strategies specifically tailored for investigating the origins of folktales. Students will explore qualitative and quantitative approaches, data analysis techniques, and literature review methods to uncover the rich history and cultural significance behind folk narratives. By honing their research skills, students will learn to trace the evolution of folktales, analyse variations across cultures, and present their findings in academic writing.

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
