READING

Readers become leaders.



Our reading-focused summer courses teach your child the skills they need to comprehend, understand, and relate to what they are reading.

These skills will help your child revise for tests, excel in exams, and even grow into a more reflective and well-rounded young person.

WRITING

You need more than knowledge to write well.

In these courses, your child will learn how to craft their message for an audience, from how to tell a story to the ins and outs of an insightful essay.

AGE 3-5



The Magic of Pixar Films



In this course, students will explore and analyze text through animated Pixar films. Students will build their confidence as they reflect and explore their own narrative voices through the timeless life lessons of the Pixar universe. As each piece fits together, they will find their own unique style of expression.

Beyond the Basics



Beyond the Basics is a personalized review and extension of the groundwork skills necessary to be a successful reader and writer in the first and second grades. Each child will have a tailored set of activities designed to reinforce and strengthen key skills in decoding, comprehension, and written composition.

Creating Storybooks



Children are natural storytellers with vivid imaginations awaiting written expression! In this course, students will craft their personal narrative in the form of an illustrated storybook that can be treasured and shared with others. They will also be guided through interactive and creative tasks to help them create the books.

Picture a Poem



In this course, students will be guided through the world of poetry as they expand their creative horizons and develop stronger reading comprehension skills. They will delve into figurative language and author's craft techniques, such as word choice and sentence fluency, as they read a curated selection of poems, create their own works, and refine their descriptive skills.

Caldecott Award Book Club

In the Book Club, students will use these award-winning works of literature as springboards from which their reading comprehension and writing skills are launched to the next level, while focusing on their inferential and critical thinking skills.

ENGLISH G 3 - 4

AGE 8-9

Creative Writing: Painting with Words

Heroes and Sheroes

In this bite-sized edition of our regular term course, students will put on their detective hats to read, solve, and write their own mystery stories. Students will build content vocabulary, put together evidence to find out "whodunnit?", and practice critical thinking skills.

I Spy with My Inner Eye



"I Spy With My Inner Eye," will use art to develop observation, thinking, and writing skills. Learn to view masterpieces in historical context and to look for what the artist needed to say. Students will get a chance to present an original project inspired by the work.

Global Changemakers



How can we help limit global warming? In this course, students will practice important nonfiction reading skills as they learn about global warming and what some "global changemakers" are doing to help. Students will become the "changemakers" as they design a product of their own to address an environmental issue and write an accompanying essay.

Creative Writing: Painting with Words

ENGLISH G7-12

AGE 12-18

Great Books



Struggling to understand the difference between stories and literature or find the themes behind the plot? You're not alone! Great Books offers students a guided tour of a bespoke literary text to develop their literacy skills. Students and coaches will choose a book and work on the entire process from reading and analyzing, to organizing and writing essays.

Academic Writing



Academic Writing rigorously prepares students for writing through high school, into university, and beyond. Students will learn how to generate and develop them in a voice appropriate for academic audiences. The skills learned and the exclusive learning materials provided in Academic Writing apply across all major curricula and academic fields.

Examining New Media



The internet age makes media literacy a crucial skill set. Students in this course will apply English literacy skills to visual and digital media found on IB, AP, iCCSE, and DSE exams, as well as in their daily lives. These foundations help develop the long-term practice that leads to success.

Creative Writing

Résumé Builder Workshop



Not simply for job seekers, a résumé is an essential tool for applying to schools – universities and boarding schools. A résumé will provide schools with an image of you as a person – your hobbies and your interests – inside and outside the classroom. In this class, we will work with students to organize their activities and their interests to summarize and highlight their achievements and what matters most to them, giving them an important roadmap to structure their applications in the future.

College Admission Essay Workshop



Get a head start on your college application! In this course, we will dig deep to brainstorm stories that will help you stand out. We will use prompts from the Common App, read through different narrative styles, and create a strong working draft that you can use for your personal statement.

SAT Bootcamp



Are you ready to become an invincible test taker? Bootcamp training is used by the military to create strong, invincible soldiers in a condensed period of time. Short. Intensive. Effective. Rigorous. Learn critical mindset techniques and test-taking skills that put you a level above everyone else on test day.

Stories at the Cinema: Mechanics of Storytelling



How is Harry Potter a classical hero? What does Thanos symbolize? By looking at popular franchises such as Harry Potter and Marvel, this course teaches the mechanics of storytelling. Students will refine existing reading and discussion skills to build towards the deeper understanding needed in high school English and beyond.

Boarding School Essay Workshop



Get a head start on your boarding school application. In this course, we will look at drafts and final essays of students just like you, and work on actual essay questions. By the end of the class, you will have a solid draft that you can adapt to many applications.



STEM

K2-3

Building with Math

There is a reason math teachers around the world have begun using “manipulatives” in their math classes: young students learn more through their hands than from words. By building, students have fun learning about materials and design, all while practicing their math skills in physical and meaningful ways.

Boom, Bloom, Wheel! Science in Action

Understanding physics begins with understanding the mechanics of motion. Students will build ramps, catapults, and other simple machines, exploring objects in motion. Some math will be included to meet the ability of students and the scientific method will be used in all activities.

G1-3

Engineering Stories

Constructing marble runs from card stock teaches kids how to take two dimensional ideas and create three dimensional objects that are stable structures. Then, like a book report, students will “map” the story in ramps so the path of the marble mimics the storyline.

Cooking up a STEAM

This course combines the art of cooking with the chemistry of heat and the biology of taste to understand what makes something so yummy. Why do we find it impossible to resist ice cream? What makes popcorn pop? Come with aprons and leave with recipes for scientific experiments you can do at home.





G4-6

Design with Minecraft

Engineers and college students are trying to figure out how to build colonies on the moon and on Mars. Science fiction authors imagine doing the same for planets circling distant stars. Now, thanks to Minecraft, we can create our own models with a bit of imagination and very real science!

Coding and Circuits


This is a hands-on course in which students create circuits to power lights and fans, art with lights, various robots, and memorabilia such as infinity photo cubes. The course can be customized to be hardware engineering, software engineering, or a mix of both, depending on the students' interests.



G7-9

Design Thinking for Inventors

Inventors solve problems. Students will use design thinking to do the same. This class will involve a lot of drawing but no drawing experience is required. There is a balance between digital work and manual work in prototyping, testing, and of course getting and applying feedback for our inventions.



PUBLIC SPEAKING

Primary School Interview Prep: Confidence Builders (K2-3)

This course aims to prepare and equip children with the necessary skills to communicate confidently and effectively. As their self-esteem blooms, their conversational and listening abilities will naturally increase. Focusing on positive interaction and logical thinking, the students will be encouraged to express themselves in a clear and structured manner.

Finding Your Voice (G1-4)

Considered to be one of the most fundamental and widely applicable skills, public speaking can be honed through practice, guidance, and inspiration - what we hope to provide. This course helps students become more confident when speaking in public and in interviews. Students will role play while improving their technique in speaking. They will also analyze, produce, and perform a range of text types.

Speak as an Expert (G5-8)

As students progress into secondary school, they are increasingly asked to make presentations in class. In this course, students will do research on a topic of their choosing, write a speech, and learn to deliver it like an expert. At the end of the course, they will be able to deliver their own informative speech in front of an audience.

我們以學生為中心,教師為主導,激發創意思維,注重因材施教;我們以普通話溝通能力和運用能力為起點,以提高學生學習中文的興趣及文學素養為基礎,力求用創意的教學內容、豐富的教學活動,提升學生綜合中文質素。

情境教學模式

針對入門課程,我們採用情境教學模式,以主題設計教學內容,通過角色扮演激發孩子們的好奇心、創造力和學習自主性,讓學生在玩樂中自然習得句式結構,擴展詞彙量。同時,我們將透過故事、兒歌、唱遊、詩詞、朗誦等有趣的語言活動,引導學生誦讀吟詠,增強語感,提升聽說能力及文學鑑賞能力。

項目學習為基礎

針對初級課程,除採用情境教學模式外,我們還採用以學生為中心,興趣為主導,項目學習為基礎的方式,差異化教學,提升學生語言運用能力,激發孩子的學習自主性和對中文探究的積極性,從而提高學習效率,養成良好的語文自習態度和習慣。

課程以主題板塊為主。每個主題單元包含不同的副題。每個主題都會涉及到思維、聽、說、讀、寫五方面能力的訓練。課堂每週一或二次,時常1至1.5小時。目前開設課程有:

學前班 (K2-3)

- 創意拼音和識字
- 創意互動唱遊和講故事
- 情境式角色模仿和扮演
- 趣味朗讀唐詩

初小班(G1-G2)

- 透過創意拼音閱讀和欣賞不同文體的自編教材,循序漸進提升讀寫能力。
- 設置情境教學模式,在主題環境下通過不同活動,提升讀寫聽說能力。
- 應用項目式學習模式,讓孩子們在過程中,運用所學知識,解決現實問題,提升自己的批判性思考能力、創造力、溝通能力、團隊合作能力。
